Math Connections: Use this book to introduce:

Growing Time (months of the year)

Activities to do Together:

- Count the number of sea creatures in the story.
- Talk your child about time, patterns, cycles, and routines related to time.
- Talk with your child about the order in which the hermit crab decorates his shell.
- Predict what will happen after the end of the story when Hermit Crab needs to get a new shell.

Extension Questions:

- 1. Are you growing? How can you tell?
- 2. Hermit Crab asked a lot of creatures to help him decorate his house. Who would you ask to help you decorate your house? Why?
- 3. How many things does he have on his shell at the end? Let's count!
- 4. What happened at the beginning of this story? What happened at the end? How are the beginning and the end of the story similar?
